

ANALYSIS OF STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ON SYLLABUS AND ITS TRANSACTION

FOR THE SESSION: 2020-2021

Students' feedback on syllabus and its transaction were taken from 110 nos. of students on 10 point printed Questionnaire.

The following are the point-wise observations of the Students:

After analyzing the students' feedback on syllabus and its transaction, it has been observed that 78 percent of the students have marked as very good on the relevance of curriculum in the context of higher education. As far as the relevance of the curriculum to the practical life/ social utilities, 91 percent students have comment as good. 92 percent of the students passed comments as very good on examination and evaluation process of the college. In respect of provision for ICT facilities, 95 percent students of the college have responded as good. . Regarding Library facilities for students, 85 percent students have mentioned as good. While analyzing the responses on admission procedures of the college, 82 percent of the students have mentioned as very good. On the other hand, 87 percent respondents responded as very good in respect of quality of teaching processes in the college. 89 percents of the students have provided opinion as good on provision of wall magazines of the college. However, in respect of provision of Fans/ Lights in the class rooms, 82 percent of the respondents have commented as good. It has been observed that 75 percent of the students commented as very good on standard/ quality of desks-benches in the class rooms of the institution.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ON SYLLABUS AND ITS TRANSACTION

The following grey areas have been identified after analysis of the feedback report collected from the students during the last academic session-2020-2021.

- Need to improve conditions of Desks-Benches in the class rooms.
- Need to increase numbers of Fans/ Lights facilities.
- Need to introduce value based curriculum in the college.
- Need to improve ICT facilities in the college.
- Upgradation of Library facilities is required.

With a view to meet up the observations from the students' feedback, initiatives have been taken for the improvement of the different areas of the college. The initiatives are as follows:-

- Steps have been taken on different areas of the college to improve infrastructure condition of the college such as increase in the numbers of Desks/ Bench in the class room.
- Initiative has also been taken to improve and increase the numbers of Fans/ Light in the class rooms.
- The college authority has taken steps to improve ICT facilities.
- Initiative has been taken for up gradation of Library facilities.

ANALYSIS OF FACULTY FEEDBACK FOR THE SESSION: 2020-2021

Teachers' feedback on syllabus and its transaction were taken from 28 nos. of teachers working against sanctioned posts on a 12 point printed Questionnaire.

The following are the point-wise observations of the faculty members:

From the faculty feedback, it has been observed that 85 percent of the faculty strongly agreed that the syllabus is not much helpful in the context of real life situation. While analyzing the effectiveness of the curriculum in the context of the present competitive world, 92 percent faculty member strongly agreed to improve curriculum so that it can help to catch up the opportunity, so that students can face the challenges of the changing world. 82 percent strongly agreed that Teaching- learning resources are available as per the need of the students in the college. 100 percent of the faculty agreed that 'the internal assessments are taking place as per the academic calendar of the college. As far as the college library is concerned, 82 percent agreed that library time schedule is maintained as per the convenience of the students and faculty of the college. Regarding extension activities, 67 percent of the faculty members have suggested for further improvement. While analyzing the feedback on class rooms and furniture availability in the college, 75 percent agreed that college have adequate class rooms and furniture to cater to the need of daily classes. With regards to toilet facilities for students and faculty, 72% teachers have remarked that there is need for further improvement. In respect to the availability of safe drinking water facilities, 82 percent agreed that college have safe drinking water facility for students and faculty. 65 percent faculty members have agreed that college sports infrastructures are adequate. In respect of efforts of authority towards college, 72 percent faculties have agreed that college authority is putting efforts for the development of the institution. 92 percent of the faculty members have agreed that IQAC of the college is working very hard for promoting quality education in the college.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT

The following points were identified after analysis of the feedback report collected from the faculty of the college during the last academic session-2020-2021

- Need for introduction of value based syllabus for real life situation.
- Need for enhancement of teaching-learning resources.
- Demand for infrastructure extension.
- Requirement for improvement of toilet facilities.
- Boost-up of more sports facilities.

With a view to meet up the observations from the faculty feedback, initiatives have been taken for the improvement of the college. The initiatives are as follows:-

- Steps have been taken to improve teaching- learning process so that student can face the challenges of the changing world.
- The college authority has taken steps to improve the infrastructure facility to meet growing demand.
- Steps have also been initiated to improve toilet facilities in the college.
- Further initiative has been taken to improve sports facility of the college.

ANALYSIS OF ALUMNI FEEDBACK TAKEN FROM 40 NUMBERS FOR THE SESSION: 2020-2021

Alumni's feedback on syllabus and its transaction were taken from 40 nos. of students on 10 point printed Questionnaire.

The following are the point-wise observations of the alumni:

Amongst the alumni 100 percent strongly agree that they feel proud to be the student of Kharupetia College. Almost 72 percent of the alumni agreed that the learning they had in the college was very much useful in their career'. 65 percent alumni agreed that the activities organized by the college for their overall development was helpful. It is found that 93 percent alumni strongly agreed in case of satisfaction about the college campus environment. While observing the feedback of alumni, it is found that 62 percent of the respondents agreed that grievances redressal mechanism in the college was very much satisfactory. In case of availability of facilities for the students in the college, 81 percent of the alumni were satisfied during their tenure. 91 percent alumni appreciated the recent developmental activities of the college. 85 percent alumni agreed that the college is providing opportunities to participate in the various socio-cultural activities of the college from time to time. 85 percent alumni have expressed their opinion that they had a role to play for financially strengthening the institution for its future progress. Regarding relevance of curriculum in context of higher education looking at practical life and its social utilities, it has been observed that 75 percent alumni agreed that it has fulfilled their need of the time.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT

The following points were identified after analysis of the feedback report collected from alumni of the Kharupetia College during the last academic session-2020-2021

- Introduction of value based curriculum in teaching-learning process
- Need for initiating experimental learning activities and participatory learning technique in teaching learning process
- Further improvement needed for quick redressal of grievances arising in the college.
- Strengthening the facilities of ICT tools for teaching learning
- Providing strong Wi-Fi connectivity for conducting online activities
- More awareness is required for engaging alumni in socio-cultural activities of the college.
- Need for awareness amongst alumni for financial contribution towards college development.

With a view to meet up the observation from the alumni feedback, strategies have been initiated for the improvement. The strategies are given below:-

- Faculty are encouraged to participate in various courses like orientation program and refreshers Course, short term courses both in online and off line mode as well as to join in programmes like SWAYAM etc.
- Initiative has been taken for students' and teachers' exchange program with neighboring colleges both online and off line mode.
- Initiatives have been taken to engage the students in environmental awareness programmes.
- Initiative has also been taken to achieve financial support from the alumni
