- 1. Skill Development: To introduce water hyacinth craft as a source of sustainable livelihood in rural areas primarily targeting the women beneficiaries for their economic empowerment. Initially the training programme will focus on Students of the Kharupetia College of Assam.
- 2. Capacity Building: Formal and Structured training on making products of water hyacinth is a necessity in promoting Water Hyacinth Craft into a Sustainable Livelihood option. In order to enhance their skills and productivity technical training and Capacity Building Programmes have been designed specific to the requirement of the artisans on water hyacinth craft.
- 3. Employment Opportunities: Promoting Water Hyacinth Craft as a Sustainable Livelihood and Establishment of Market Linkages a systematic approach to promote Water Hyacinth Craft as a sustainable Livelihood option, marketing linkage has to be established and tracking of the growing needs of customers is also to be kept in account.
- 5. Community Outreach: Engage in outreach programs to uplift the socio-economic conditions of the local community. This includes initiatives such as skill-building workshops for the community, and other socially responsible activities.
