

FROM 25TH MARCH TO 31ST MARCH 2023

In response to the instruction of students' welfare department of Gauhati University, The Principal of our College Dr. Mausumi Saha Kalita issued an order to execute the Survey Program on "Youth not in Formal Education" at nearby village of our college Nagazan. So, the NSS Unit of the Kharupetia College and I, as a NSS Programme Officer of NSS unit, Kharupetia College arranged the Survey with 30 (Thirty) numbers of NSS Volunteers arrange for survey of the village to identify the grey area of the village for future course of action. of the Survey was done from 25th March to 31st March/23. NSS Unit of the College along with its volunteers continuously surveyed for 7 days at Nagazan village. About 110 household were verified and out of 110 numbers of households, we have identified only 32 numbers of households where such categories of youths were found.

From the survey report it has been observed that out of the 110 numbers of households about 30% youths (15 to 29 yrs of age) are not getting formal education which is very sad message for the upcoming present societies. For the reason, NSS Unit Kharupetia college carried out various awareness drive to reduce the rate of illiteracy amongst them to uplift the area and the society at large.
