8. Analysis:

For the study of the students' satisfaction survey, we have collected information from 208 respondents from the 5th Semester students of Kharupetia College by using questionnaires. After analyzing the responses, it has been noticed that 74 percent of the students said that 70 to 84 percent syllabus has already been covered. About 67 percent respondents mentioned that teachers come to the class with through preparation of the subject to be taught in the class. At the same time 73 percent respondents have provided their opinion regarding communication skill of the teacher as always effective. Again 80 percent of the students' commented on the evaluation processes where response was always fair. A sizable numbers of students strongly agreed that teaching and monitoring help them in improvement of Teaching- learning processes as well as social and emotional growth of them. 65 percent of the respondents strongly agreed that the

college provide multiple opportunities to learn and grow. Out of 208 respondents, 69 percent students have said that the teachers are able to identify their weakness in every time which helps them to overcome their problem in learning. 64 percent respondents mention that usually teachers explain the concept through examples and by application of various techniques in the class. The survey also discloses that 55 percent of the respondents strongly agreed that the teachers encourage participating in the extracurricular activities for all-round development of the students. 53 percent of the respondents said that to a greater extent the teachers used students centric methods such as experimental learning, participative learning in the college. In respect of overall qualities in the college, 67 percent of the respondents strongly agreed that it is very good. From the students survey it has been reflected that the use of ICT tools by the teachers need to be increased in the college. The respondents have suggested improving the overall teaching - learning process by increasing the number of books in the Library, Providing more digital classes, improving laboratory farcicalities for practical oriented subjects.




